An apprenticeship snapshot for Wiltshire

October 2019

This newsletter was produced by the Employment and Skills Service at Wiltshire Council to showcase employers, providers and the range of opportunities available through the apprenticeship route.

Apprenticeships in Wiltshire

Wiltshire saw 5720 apprenticeships started between August 2017 and July 2018.

The parliamentary constituency of South West Wiltshire which includes the towns and villages of Trowbridge, Warminster and Westbury accounted for 970 of these starts across all sectors and levels.



Starts for the first three quarters of this academic year (August to April) show continued apprenticeship growth with a total of 4290 starts recorded for Wiltshire; 750 of which were across the South West Wiltshire constituency.

Apprenticeship Reforms – What's new?

Non-levy paying employers will share the cost of training and assessing their apprentices with government - this is called 'co-investment'.

The co-investment rate has changed for new apprenticeships starting on or after 1 April 2019. You will now pay 5% towards the cost of apprenticeship training. The government will pay the rest (95%) up to the <u>funding band maximum</u>.

All apprenticeships that started before 1 April 2019 will continue at the previous co-investment rate of 10%.



The Apprenticeship Ambassador Network is for businesses who have apprentices in their workforce regardless of size or industry.

Current and former apprentices can provide inspiration for the next generation by attending events and speaking at local schools; providing an insight into their day to day work roles.

An alternative to university!

Higher and Degree level apprenticeships are an area of rapid growth and offer a real alternative to university for applicants and not just for those that live in large cities such as London, Bristol and Birmingham. There are some great opportunities across Swindon and Wiltshire from businesses such as Arla Foods, Bew & Co, Hartham Park, Siemens and Zircon Software.

Applications for these programmes often open well in advance of the job starting, usually between October and March to start the following September. It is therefore important to sign up to the Find an Apprenticeship service website where you can opt in to receive alerts as vacancies are announced based on your criteria or location.
