Our Education, Employment Advisors and Building Bridges team will be at the Town Hall Wednesday afternoons 1pm – 3:30pm.

The space has a café which means meetings can be casual and informal, we hope to form relationships with young people to enable them to gain an understanding of the support and opportunities that are out there waiting for them! Building on the success of last year the team will be able to help Year 11 pupils without secure plans and in need of greater intervention to make a successful transition from school.
