Are you working with somebody who is looking to return to work after a career break? Or struggling to decide what to do since leaving school? Or experience barriers which require 1-1 support?

Building Bridges is a free programme which can support those facing barriers or challenges in returning to the workplace or education and overcome them. It is open to anyone, aged 15+, in Wiltshire or Swindon who is not in Education or Employment.
