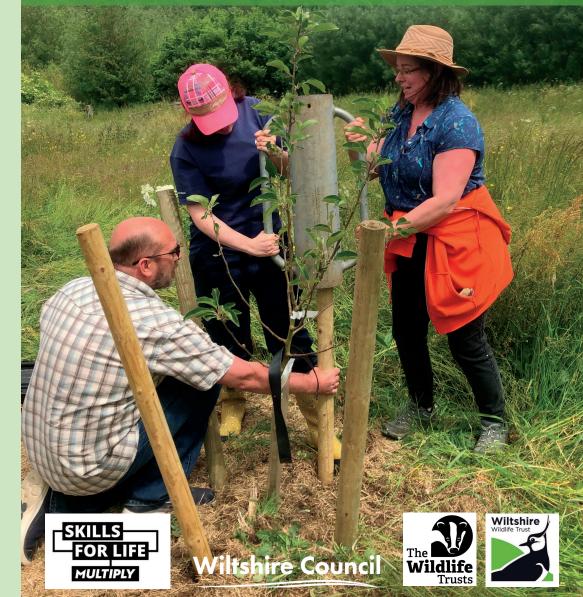

Who is it for?

The programme is open to adults aged 18+ who have not achieved a Level 2 Maths qualification (GCSE Grade C/4 or equivalent) or who want to brush up on those skills. Participants will:

- Improve mental and physical wellbeing
- Connect with nature and learn new skills
- Meet new people in a safe and supportive environment

- Free hot lunch cooked over the campfire, tea/coffee, fruit and biscuits (please bring drinking water)





Activities
